The Diocese of Sheffield is preparing to say farewell next month to the Bishop of Doncaster, Cyril Ashton, and his wife Muriel at a special service in Doncaster Minster on **Wednesday 13 July (7.30pm)**, celebrating his ministry as bishop.

Clergy from across the Diocese will be joined by a wide section of people representing the local community to share in a celebration of hymns, readings and music.

The former Bishop of Sheffield, Jack Nicholls, who appointed Bishop Cyril as Bishop of Doncaster, will give the address.
