Weekend **Friday 14th – Sunday 16th.** Possible fundraising event for St Marys.

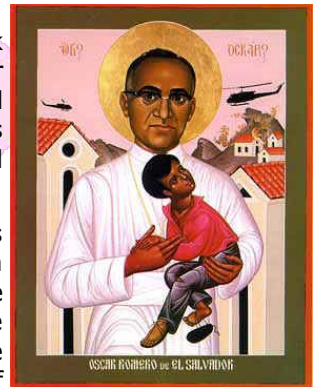
3. Is this you?

Oscar Romero

Its 30 years this week since Archbishop Oscar Romero was shot dead while celebrating mass in his native El Salvador.

He sat and ate beans and drank coffee with the poorest and spoke out on behalf of the poor and the oppressed at a time of terrible political violence in his country.



He became 250,000 attended his funeral and he inspired a generation to struggle for the rights and needs of the poor, in Latin America and beyond.

"I am bound as a pastor, by divine command, to give my life for those whom I love, and that is all Salvadorans, even those who are going to kill me."

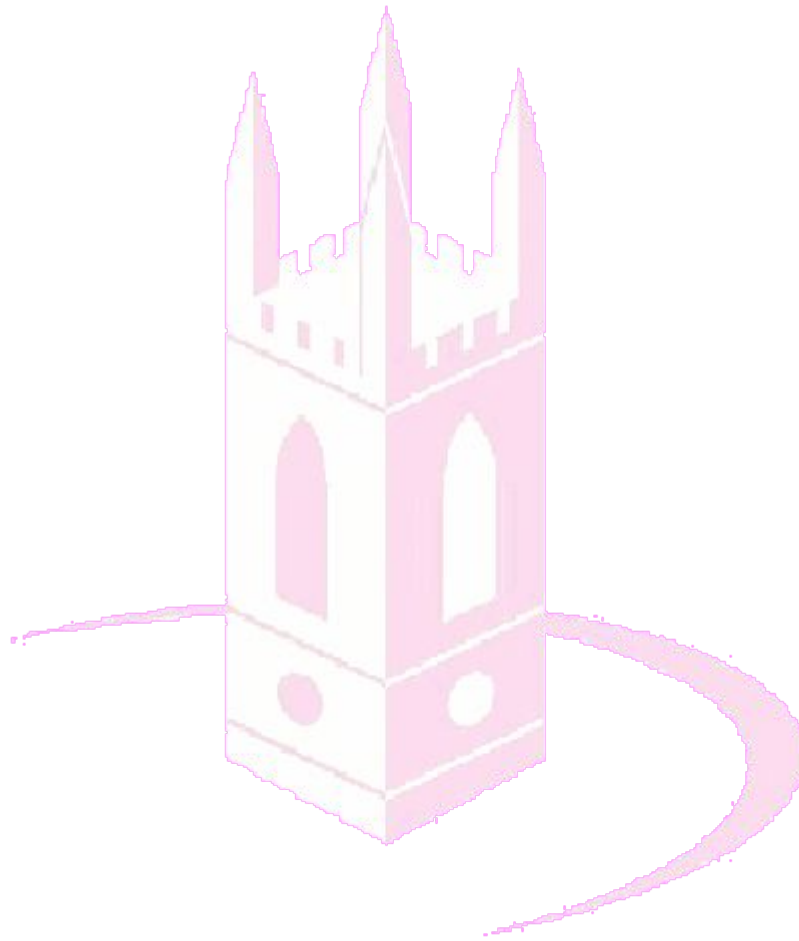
