## Campaign Against Deportation Of Odette Sefuko (CADOS)

---

The 2nd meeting was held on Tuesday 11 May 2010.

The Barrister had recommended that her case was suitable to go to the European Court of Human Rights. The current legal situation for Odette was discussed, her case had been refused by the High Tribunal Court. There were now no further avenues of Appeal in the UK> This makes her position in this country very tenuous and there is a need for urgent action to gain as much support for her as possible. The meeting decided we would ask supporters if they would give £1 or £2 in order to start a campaign fund to pay for paper/stamps/materials etc. All donations would go to Maureen F who had agreed to be Treasurer. Another meeting will be held **at 7.30pm on Tuesday 25th May**. Please ask Kate if you would like to help (or to find out where this meeting will be!).
