A dreadful bomb attack at an Anglican Church in Nairobi recently, resulted in the death of a child, and 6 children being

badly injured. The picture shows our friend Joel, the Bishop of Nairobi, with the Archbishop of Kenya, Dr. Eliud Wabukala as they visited and prayed with the children in hospital. The Archbishop commented: "This is a cruel provocation, but I appeal to Christians not to feed violence with violence, either in word or deed, because we are called to overcome evil with good."


This year we have received grants to pay our youth worker, Clare, but need to find the additional costs associated with employing her.
