HSBC CITY RIDE

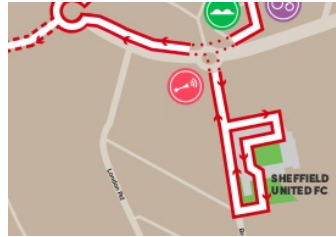
